Learning and teaching (EIA)

Goal – Develop a consistent whole-school pedagogical approach to Mathematics that promotes problem-solving and reasoning that stretches and challenges our students to increase engagement and achievement.

- **Strategies** whole school planning documents, range of data sets to measure progress, engage in professional learning with experts, provide regular opportunities to collaborate, moderate and annotate.
- Success measures student disposition data, teacher reflection/confidence data, parent perspective, daily/weekly implementation of identified pedagogical practices, LWT, staff internal and and external PD attendance, evidence of assessment, curriculum alignment, pedagogical practices and differentiation in planning.

Wellbeing

Goal – Promote and support staff well-being and sustainable work practices.

Strategies – establish a staff working group, prep and post surveys, engage external consultants, Term 3 whole staff retreat.

Success measures – increase in staff satisfaction.

Diversity and inclusion

Goal – Develop a consistent approach to the explicit teaching of reading in Years P- 2 through the use of the Sounds Write program to improve students' reading, spelling and writing abilities.

Strategies – Train P-2 teachers in the Sounds Write Program, resource and support teacher implementation.

Success measures – increase in student achievement in Reading.
