PREP



Prep Students have been working on their collaborative canvases over many, many weeks and learning about basic shapes and colour theory. They have also been learning about an Austrian artist, Hundertwasser, who loved round shaped flowers and bright colours. Preps have all drawn and painted their own flower and signed their names on the back on the canvas behind their flower.

YEAR 1



Vincent van Gogh has been a big inspiration in the creation of the year one's collaborative canvases. Bright, warm coloured sunflowers were painted on to the canvas by each child. Students were delighted to see how the warm colours stand out on the cool coloured background. Some of the children helped the teacher create the background with applying paint onto the canvas with different mark making tools.

GRADE 2



Poppies were the subject matter for year two's collaborative canvases. The background was created by some of the children along with the teacher by making marks on the canvas with different tools. The intention was to create lots of different cool tones so the red and orange coloured poppies would stand out.

Each child used a special shaped brush dipped in different tones of warm colours to press onto the canvas to create their own poppy. Georgia O'Keeffe, and American artist was the inspiration for this work with her famous 'Red Poppies' painting

YEAR 3



Students in year three read the story 'How The Birds Got Their Colours', one of their favourite stories from Aboriginal Dreamtime. They all thought about what Australian bird they would like to be and went about researching, observing, drawing and colouring their very own bird. The background was discussed and the children all come up with their own ideas. Some of the students collaborated with the teacher to create the background. The birds were then collaged on to create their own interpretation of how their birds got their colours.

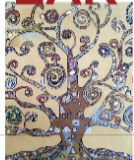
YEAR 4



Students were learning about the Indigenous Culture of Australia and we learned that a lot of the artists were often inspired by the land and everything to do with the land. Plants, seedpods, flowers, rocks, sticks, animals, rivers, bush tucker etc. So the children chose an object from nature, observed it closely, drew it and repeated shapes to make their own pattern or symbol inspired by their chosen object. These individual patterns and symbols were then recreated onto a canvas. Some of the canvases are very abstract and some are of a recognisable animal, filled with the individual artwork of the artists in year 4.

2017 SUNDAY FUNDAY ART AUCTION

YEAR 5



Students in year 5 were learning about the Gold Rush in their classroom. Gustav Klimt was an artist who used a lot of gold in his artwork so he became an inspiration for the collaborative canvases. One of his famous paintings, 'The Tree Of Life' was a focus in the art room. Klimt had a bird sitting in his tree, so the children had to include one in their individual 'Tree of Life' drawings. Meanwhile a Tree of life was being recreated onto a collaborative canvas by the artists in year 5M. Each child had a section of the tree to create and decorate with their own symbols and patterns inspired by Klimt.

5G After seeing one of the artists in year 5 draw a bird, the class decided they wanted to create a large bird onto their collaborative canvas. Three or four of the students drew the bird sitting in the tree and each child had a section to fill in with their own patterning and their symbol in the bird.

5 D had two weeks to create a collaborative canvas, so the teacher drew a large cat to save time and each student filled in a section with their own patterning inspired by Klimt. A cat was chosen because Klimt loved cats.

YEAR 6



Students were learning about Australian Federation in the classroom. So in art we looked at the architecture from around that time and because we lived in Queensland we decided to look at the typical Queenslander. Students individually drew their own Queenslander and this was then collaged onto a collaborative canvas. To make it feel like Queensland, a few palm trees were added and the students wanted a beach near their little village.
