Ingredients
11/2 cops (3359) nhite sugur
$1 / 2$ cup ( $(25 \mathrm{sm}$ ) honey
$1 / 3 \operatorname{cosp}(80 \mathrm{~m})$ water
2 tablespoons gioiden syup
2 teasppoons bicabibonate of soda
200 g dark chocolate, chopped

## Method

(1) Grease and line an oven tray with baking paper.
(2) Combine sugar, honey, water and golden syrup in a medium saucepan. Place over low heat and cook stirring, occasionally brushing down side of the pan and spoon with a pastry brush dipped in water to remove any sugar crystals, for $5-7$ minutes or untili sugar dissolves.
(3) Increase heat to high and bring to the boil. Cook, without stirring, for $5-7$ minutes or until the syrup reaches crack stage ( $154^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ ) on a sugar thermometer. Remove from heat and set aside for bubbles to subside.
(4) Add the bicarbonate of soda and quickly stir with a wooden spoon until combined (mixture will bubble and foam). Pour onto the tray and set aside to cool completely.
(5) Place the chocolate in a heatproof bowl over a saucepan of simmering water. Stir occasionally with a metal spoon until chocolate melts and is smooth.
(C) Turn the honeycomb onto a clean surface. Break into large pieces. Drizzle chocolate over honeycomb pieces and put aside to set. Store in an airtight containet.

## Coconut Roughs



Ingredients
$11 / 2$ cups shredded coconut $200 g$ block mili chocolate, chapped 100 g dark chocolate, chopped

## Method

(1) Preheat oven to $180^{\circ} \mathrm{C} / 160^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ fan-forced. Line a large baking tray with baking paper. Spread coconut on prepared tray. Bake for 5 minutes, stirring halfway through cooking, or until golden and toasted. Set coconut aside to cool completely.

2 Place chocolates in a heatproof, microwave-safe bowl. Melt in the microwave until smooth and runny.

3 Put aside a couple of tablespoons toasted coconut. Mix the remaining toasted coconut to melted chocolate and stir until well combined. Set aside for 5 minutes.
4. Use the lined tray from earlier and spoon tablespoonfulls of the mixture onto prepared trays and shape into 4.5 cm discs. Sprinkle the centre of each disc with reserved toasted coconut.

5 Alternatively this mixture could be poured into paper patty pans (used for small cakes) to gice a regulr shape or a chocolate mould could be used.

Allow to cool and harden. Store in an airtight container.
