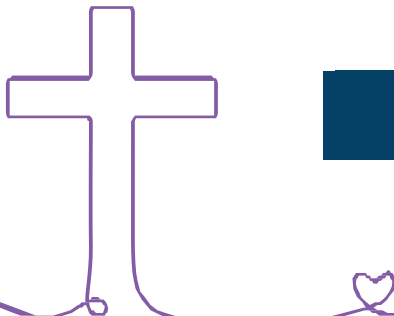
At St Martins, we live our vision through our commitment to the four Dominican pillars of Prayer, Learning, Community and Service.
